HOW DO WE STOP Deforestation?

We work together to protect the health of the rainforest, its people, & our climate

HOW IT WORKS

1. SUSTAINABLE FORESTRY

Our foresters harvest 3 trees per acre every 20 years. This low-impact management protects critical habitats for rare species and avoids deforestation driven by agricultural expansion thus keeping large amounts of carbon stored in a healthy forest.

2. COMMUNITY PARTNERS

We create local jobs in forestry and wood products manufacturing, which pay 6 times more than farming. With a higher income, families can plan for their future. That's why they partner with us rather than cut forests for farming.

3. CONSCIOUS CONSUMER (YOU)

Your buying power is what protects the forest, and gives craftsmen the opportunity to support their families. You prevent carbon emissions from deforestation, substantially lowering your carbon footprint.

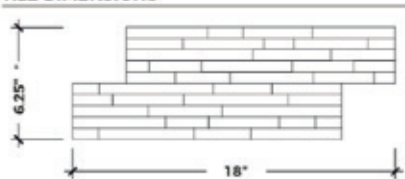

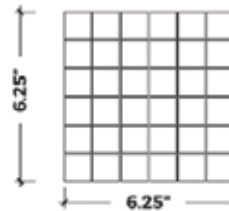

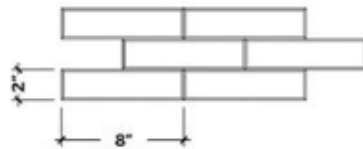

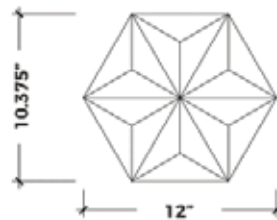

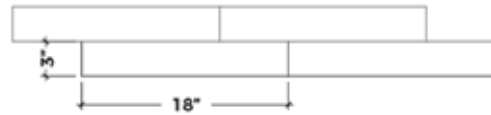

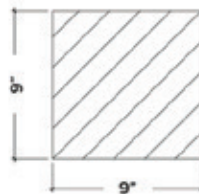

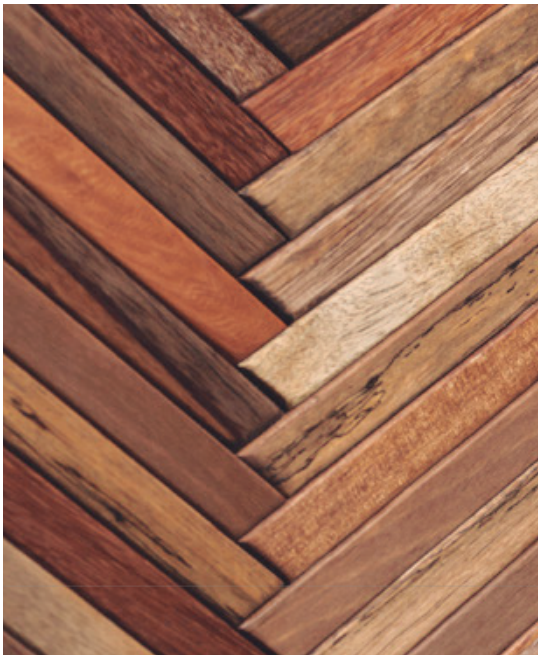

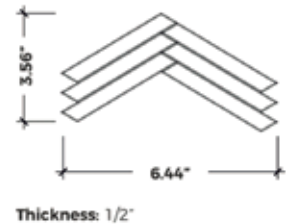

DETAILS

Starting at \$8/SF

Color Mix: Jungle, warm, cool, dark and light.

Character: May include spalting or filled insect marks; free of soft density wood

Carbon Value: Calculated per project; prevents .02 tons of CO2 emissions per SF

Profile: Tongue and groove

Dimensions: 12", random lengths, or custom lengths



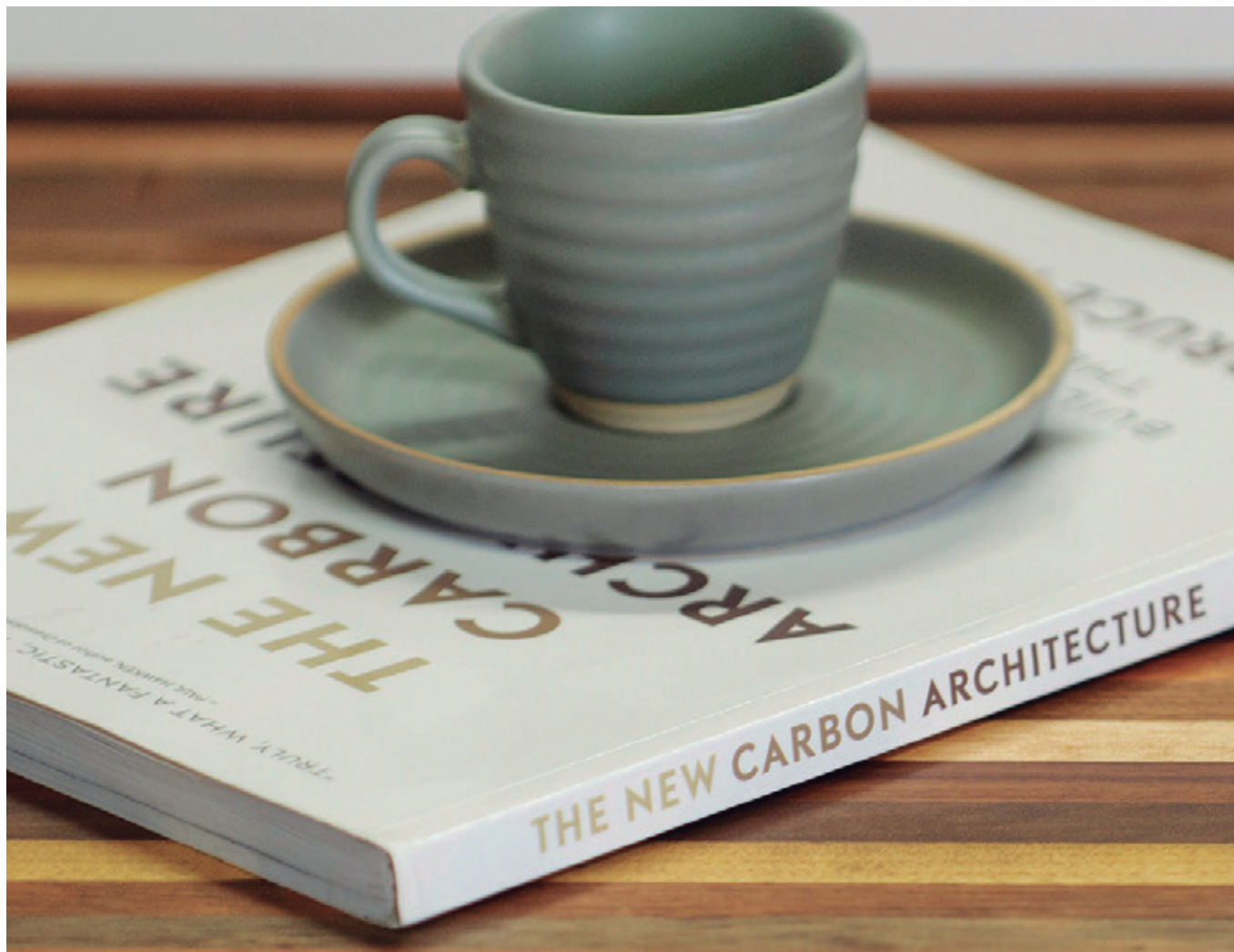

FEES & POLICIES

OPTIONS

Small Batch Fee	\$150 for small batch; dependent on product type
Rush Fee	Add 30%; when production is possible
Custom Finish	Add 30% to SF price
Custom Design	Estimated at time of order

CUSTOMIZATION

If the range of colors that can be included in a project is limited, we are able to ensure the inclusion or exclusion of up to two species.

We prefer to use Rubio Monocoat, but custom finishes are available. If required by the project, we have the capability to color match specified finishes.

SHIPPING

Products are shipped through UPS, or via our freight carrier. An added cost for crate shipping may be applied.

Shipping estimates may be modified if final shipping cost varies.

In order to ship, we will need contact information for an on-site manager.

Expedited shipping will require extra cost. We do not profit off of shipping—we only charge you the difference.

ORDERING

Lead Time

Lead times average 6-8 weeks, but are estimated at time of order. They are our best estimate—they're not a guarantee.

Order Confirmation

- For each sample you receive, we have created a control sample for our records to confirm a match.

Order Modification

For custom orders, we cannot make large changes once the order is confirmed. If you require a change, please contact us immediately so we can resolve the matter.

Returns

- We guarantee our products, so if there is a failure in the product (as defined by the contract), we will replace the product at no cost.

PAYMENT METHODS
