Handmade by Friendship Bridge® was known as the Artisan Market Access Program in 2015 and became its own brand in 2019. As a learning organization, Friendship Bridge has evolved substantially since it began work in Guatemala in 1998 to support women living in poverty and with limited economic opportunities. It has diversified its offerings and provided additional products and services since its founding. Friendship Bridge discovered-through surveys and researchthe need of many of the artisan women for access to new markets to sell their products and bolster their income. However, many of the artisans faced geographical and language barriers and/or did not have the business skills necessary to thrive in today's marketplace.
